PROGRAM FEATURES

- The Professional Immersion Program (PIP) starts in week 3 of your first session. You will be placed in a local school for an introduction to the profession where you will experience real
- school culture and observe teachers teaching and students learning.
- Our blended delivery model includes face-to-face lecture, tutorial and workshop classes, and flexible online learning. Classes may be scheduled weekly or as block intensives.
- Each subject includes up to 3 hours of face-to-face classes and/ or online class activities each week. Classes may be scheduled from 8:30am to 7:30pm throughout the week. You will be expected to commit an additional 12 hours per week of personal study time to each subject.
- The program is taught by dedicated professionals and practicing teachers.
