Whether you are a recent graduate or an established educator, this program will provide you with a firm foundation for pursuing higher level positions in educational leadership, management or policy.

THIS DEGREE

The Master of Education (Educational Leadership) is a higher degree for educators wishing to pursue postgraduate studies in educational leadership. This degree is for people who are currently in leadership roles or who wish to pursue leadership positions in educational organisations including schools, educational training providers and educational policy and administration fields.

WHAT YOU WILL STUDY

This Master's degree is flexible, allowing students to study online or on campus.

Sound theoretical foundations and extensive practical skills addressing areas such as change management, mentoring and curriculum leadership provide students with the skills to investigate and solve complex issues in a rapidly changing educational climate

During this degree students will also conduct an individualised research project that aligns with work, interests and study specialisation.

This degree provides the opportunity to incorporate electives from other education areas such as Information Communication Technology (ICT), Special Education or Literacy in order to tailor their degree.

This 2 year degree combines the Master of Education (Educational Leadership) degree with further studies in either Higher Education, TESOL or Information and Communication Technology in Education and Training.

ADVANCED STANDINGS

24 credit points (4 subjects) of advanced standings can be requested by anyone with a recognised teaching qualification and 3+ years of full time teaching experience. This reduces the Master of Education (Educational Leadership) to just 48 credit points (1 year full time) and the Master of Education Advanced (Educational Leadership) to 72 credit points (1.5 years full time).
