## Supporting individuals on the autism spectrum with challenging behaviours

**PROGRAM:** Saturday, 8th September 2018 | 9.00 – 4.00 pm

This workshop will focus on supporting individuals on the autism spectrum who exhibit challenging behaviours. Participants will gain insight into underlying reasons that individuals on the autism spectrum may demonstrate these behaviours and how they can determine when they need to intervene. Participants will learn how to conduct a functional analysis of challenging behaviours in order to describe the specific behaviour of concern and to collect data to identify possible antecedents and consequences that are causing and maintaining the behaviour. Participants will be guided in constructing a hypothesis about the purpose of the behaviour and will learn about strategies, which have been found to be effective in helping individuals on the autism spectrum to develop more behaviours that will better enable them to obtain their desired objective.
